Legislation Update: Priority Bills You Need to Know

State Budget Update

Deficit is Approximately \$73 billion. On January 10th Governor Newsom released his new state budget for the 2024-25 fiscal year. At that time, the Governor pegged the General Fund deficit at \$38 billion in contrast to the LAO estimate of \$58 billion.



Priority Bill Issues

The CLCA is currently tracking numerous legislative bills. Here are some of the most important ones and the stance CLCA is taking on each of them (supported or opposed).



<u>AB 2011 - Small employer family leave mediation</u> makes the Civil Rights Department small employer family leave mediation program permanent, benefiting both workers and small employers, reducing the threat of litigation for small businesses.



AB 2371 - Electrified security fences prevents local CA governments from implementing a full ban on electric security fencing on commercial or similarly designated properties as long as the fencing follows CA Civil Code 835 /1.



AB 2622 - Contractors: exemptions: advertisements Current CA Contractors State License Law exempts licensing requirements on any work or operation on one undertaking or project when the aggregate contract price does not exceed \$500. This bill increases the maximum aggregate contract price exemption to \$5,000.



<u>SB 1116 - Unemployment insurance for union strikers</u> authorizes striking workers to receive unemployment insurance (UI) benefits. The CA Chamber of Commerce opposes this bill. Fiscal impact adds to CA UI Fund deficit to be repaid through UI taxes on California employers.



AB 2200 - Universal single-payer health care coverage expands CA gov't control over healthcare. It eliminates private insurance and choice-based healthcare options by creating a new state-run health care system. Cal-Chamber estimates the cost to CA taxpayers at more than \$400 billion.



AB 2947 - Water Conservation: Turf Conversion Programs provides an opportunity to realize water savings on turf landscapes by installing climate appropriate turf coupled with the most efficient irrigation equipment available. This bill requires CA Department of Water resources to make available grant funds accessible for Turf Conversion rebate programs where existing turf is replaced with climate appropriate turfgrass or other groundcovers that use less water in addition to related provisions.

Beautification Awards: Call for Entries!

The CLCA SLO chapter awards encompass categories covering residential and commercial landscape construction, maintenance, and design/build, along with hardscape, outdoor lighting, and sustainable landscaping. This is one of the chapter's biggest events.

Submit your best projects from this past year! We are offering a discount on the entry fees to help maximize your number of entries – pay to enter two projects and get the third free (what a deal!). The entry fee for each project is \$150 and to qualify for this discount must be received on or before

Monday, May 13, 2024.

Projects will be judged by retired experts in the landscaping field or other experts from outside of our chapter area. They will be looking at the skill and quality of workmanship of every aspect of your project. Don't forget to spruce up your projects for final presentation. Previous construction entries (non-winners) may be re-entered, as long as the completion date adheres to this year's date. All previous maintenance entries (as well as new entries) may be entered every year.
