



Harassment Prevention Webinars in English and Spanish

Do you have 5 or more employees? If you have 5 or more employees, a just updated law mandates that you must provide harassment prevention training: One hour for employees and two hours for supervisors and managers. CLCA is offering training webinars in October, in English and Spanish, for employees and supervisors.

Also, a new law extends the deadline to complete initial training by a year and allows employers who have provided training in 2019 to wait two full years before providing refresher training.


